## Tigers Aim for First Win over 23rd-Ranked Trinity in SCAC Showdown

DePauw takes a 4-1 overall record and a 2-1 Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference mark into Saturday's showdown with visiting and 23rd-ranked Trinity (4-1, 1-1). Kickoff from Blackstock Stadium is set for 1 p.m.

DePauw opened the season with wins over Anderson, Centre and Sewanee for the best start in 22 years. The Tigers then lost at home to defending SCAC champion Millsaps before rebounding with a 28-24 win at Birmingham-Southern last Saturday.

Trinity dropped a 27-13 decision at Rhodes last week after opening the season with wins over East Texas Baptist, Texas Lutheran, Colorado College and Birmingham-Southern.

### SCOUTING TRINITY

Trinity opened the season with four straight wins by an average margin of over three touchdowns per game before dropping a 27-13 SCAC decision at Rhodes last Saturday.

Quarterback Blake Barmore directs the offense

with an efficiency rating of 155.1 which ranks 22nd in Division III. Barmore completes over 64 percent of his passes and averages over 265 yards per game which ranks 20th in the nation.

Barmore's top receivers include Riley Curry with 26 catches for 377 yards and Chris Coleman with 19 receptions totaling 295 yards.

Philip Kownslar leads the defense with 38 total tackles including four for loss. Lee Patterson is next with 33 stops, while Ronald Satterthwaite leads the way with 3.0 sacks. Brian Marynowitz is the team leader with two interceptions. Trinity's defense ranks 17th in the nation by allowing just 239.2 yards per contest.

### DEPAUW UPDATE

The Tigers are coming off a 28-24 win at Birmingham-Southern in which they scored the game-winning touchdown on Spud Dick's 21-yard pass to Bryan Mulligan with 44 seconds left.

The Tigers totaled 478 yards of offense in the win and the contest marked the third time this season that the Tigers accumulated both 200 passing and rushing yards in the same game.

Dick directs the offense and has thrown for over 200 yards in each of the five contests this season. Mulligan is his top receiver with 35 receptions for 414 yards. Alex Koors is next with 22 catches, while Chris Gasbarra and Jeff Bonner have hauled in 17 and 16 catches, respectively. Jeremiah Marks has missed the last three games, but averaged 148.5 rushing yards per game in the Tigers' first two games.

Defensively, DePauw is limiting teams to just 322 yards of offense and only 111 on the ground.

Ryan McElwain paces the defensive unit with 35 tackles, while Marc Hoepfner is next with 33. J.J. Costello leads the squad with 6.0 tackles for loss, while Tyler Doane leads the way with 4.5 sacks including 3.5 last Saturday. Jevon Pruitt ranks 11th in the nation with 0.8 interceptions per game.

**NOTES**

The Tigers have won five of their last six games at Blackstock Stadium and nine of their last 11 ... in 66 seasons at Blackstock Stadium, DePauw teams have posted a 177-124-5 record for a .587 winning percentage ... DePauw is 3-0 on the road this season and the last time a Tigers team finished unbeaten on the road was in 2004 when DePauw went 5-0 away from Blackstock Stadium on the way to an 8-2 season ... the Tigers are looking to go 5-1 for the third straight year ... DePauw has outscored the opposition 27-0 in the first quarter of games this year. Centre was the last team to score in the opening stanza against the Tigers (10/28/06) ... DePauw's 24 points allowed in the first three games was the best defensive start to a season since 1980 when opponents scored just 10 over the opening three weeks ... **Jeremiah Marks** recorded his school record 16th 100-yard rushing game with his 164-yard performance against Centre and lifted his career school record total to 3,217 yards which also ranks fourth in SCAC history ... Marks also added to his DePauw record of 45 touchdowns and 270 points. The 45 touchdowns rank second in SCAC history behind Tim McDaniel's (Centre) 54, while his 270 points are third in SCAC history ... **Curtis Moore's** 182 rushing yards in last week's win at Birmingham-Southern equaled the eighth-highest single-game total in DePauw history ... **Tyler Doane** was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week after recording eight tackles including 3.5 sacks in the win at Birmingham-Southern ... **Jevon Pruitt** ranks 11th in Division III with 0.8 interceptions per game ... Pruitt was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week for his performance against Centre ... DePauw's 14 interceptions rank second in Division III behind Wisconsin-Stevens Point's 15 ... the Tigers rank 14th in the nation with 3.8 sacks per game and 16th with a +1.6 turnover margin ... since beginning SCAC play in 1998, DePauw teams have posted a 39-17 record in SCAC games including a 20-8 home record and a 19-9 road mark.

**UP NEXT**

DePauw travels to Colorado Springs next Saturday for its first-ever meeting with Colorado College. The Tigers' next home game is on Saturday, October 27, when DePauw entertains Austin on Old Gold Day.
