DePauw (14-4, 6-2) at Southwestern (8-9, 4-4)

**Tiger Tipoff**

The Tigers return to Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference action when they travel to Southwestern University on Friday, February 1. Tipoff from Southwestern's Robertson Center is set for 8 p.m. CST.

DePauw is 14-4 overall and 6-2 in the SCAC after Sunday's 90-83 win over 18th-ranked Millsaps. In that game, Mike Moore led the Tigers with 24 points and five assists, while Brian Oilar matched a career-high with 14 rebounds.

Moore leads the team with 17.4 points and 6.4 assists per game which ranks ninth in Division III. He also leads the team with 47 three-pointers and has hit 44.3 percent from three-point range.

Brian Oilar follows with 13.6 points while hitting 56.6 percent from the floor and hauling down a team-high 8.3 rebounds. Stephen Schott rounds out the double-figure scorers with 13.4 points per contest and grabs 7.8 rebounds. Four Tigers have made at least 25 three-pointers and connected on at least 39 percent from beyond the arc.

Southwestern is 8-9 overall and 4-4 in the SCAC following last Saturday's 66-59 loss at Oglethorpe. In that game, Mike Powell led the Pirates with 20 points, while Matt Caplan grabbed six rebounds. The Pirates have won three of their last four after dropping the previous five.

Powell is the team's lone double-figure scorer with 11.1 points per game and leads the squad with 1.9 assists. Caplan follows with 9.3 points and leads the team with 5.2 rebounds and 30 three-pointers. In all, 11 different players play at least 11 minutes per game.

**RADIO:** WGRE (91.5 FM and www.wgre.org) provides live action locally and on the Internet.

**SERIES:** DePauw leads the all-time series 12-5 after winning last year's only meeting by a 59-51 score in Greencastle. The Tigers are 6-1 in games played at Southwestern and won the last game in Georgetown by a 74-71 score on January 16, 2005.

# DePauw Miscellaneous Statistics

► DePauw has made at least one three-pointer in each of the last 435 games. The last time the Tigers failed to connect on a trey was against Taylor on February 19, 1991.

► **Stephen Schott** has scored 1,283 career points and ranks 11th on DePauw's all-time scoring list. He needs 25 to pass Tom McCormick (1966-69). Schott ranks fourth with 756 rebounds and needs six to move ahead of Joe Ringger (1999-03). Schott is sixth with 337 career free throws made.

He is one of just three DePauw players with 1,200 points and 700 rebounds and one of just five in SCAC history to accomplish the feat. Schott ranks fifth in SCAC rebounding history and can move into third place with six more.

► **Mike Moore's** 406 career assists already rank third in school history. He needs 85 to pass Mike Howland (1998-02). Moore led the SCAC in assists each of the last two years.

► **Mike Moore's** 149 career three-pointers made are fifth in school history. He needs needs 36 to pass Joe Nixon (1998-02).

► **Brian Oilar's** 49 career blocked shots rank seventh in school history and he needs three to pass Matt McDonald (2003-07).

## BILL FENLON DePauw Head Coach

The winningest coach in DePauw men's basketball history, Bill Fenlon begins his 16th season as the Tigers' head coach and 23rd on the collegiate level. He is also a part-time assistant professor of kinesiology.

Fenlon's DePauw teams have posted a 250-141 record for a .639 winning percentage. Only Elmer McCall and Donovan Moffett have longer tenures as DePauw basketball head coaches. In 22 previous seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fenlon's teams have posted a 357-210 record for a .630 winning percentage.

Last season, Fenlon led the Tigers to their second consecutive trip to the NCAA Division III postseason as DePauw earned an at-large bid to the tournament. The Tigers dropped a 62-59 first-round overtime decision to Whitworth on a buzzer-beating three-pointer.

The 22-6 Tigers posted the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history and earned the top seed in the SCAC tournament after sharing the league's best record during the regular season.

In 2005-06, he directed the Tigers to their first SCAC tournament championship and 13th trip to NCAA postseason play. The Tigers dropped a 76-68 decision to host Wisconsin-Whitewater in the opening round game.

In 2002-03 the Tigers earned their second consecutive SCAC regular season title and the team ranked sixth in Division III rebound margin.

In 2002 he led DePauw to its first SCAC championship and a bid into the NCAA Championship. The 24-4 Tigers defeated Wittenberg in the second round and knocked off top-ranked Washington (Mo.) in the round of 16 before falling to eventual national champion Otterbein in the quarterfinals. Fenlon earned SCAC Coach of the Year honors and the Tigers were ranked fourth in the final D3hoops.com poll.

In 2000-01, he led the Tigers to a 19-6 record and a third-place finish in the SCAC. The team ranked eighth in Division III rebound margin, ninth in scoring defense, 20th in scoring margin and 28th in three-point percentage.

In 1999-2000 he directed a team of primarily freshmen and sophomores, to a second-place finish in their second year in the SCAC and a top-25 national ranking during the season.

In his first season with the Tigers in 1992-93, Fenlon led the Old Gold to an Indiana Collegiate Athletic Conference championship and a fourth straight appearance in the NCAA Division III tournament despite being picked to finish third in the ICAC in a preseason poll of coaches. The Tigers ranked first in the nation in three-point percentage (45.6) and 11th in scoring defense (61.3) that season.

In 1994 the Tigers ranked ninth in Division III in scoring defense (62.9) and posted the best field goal percentage defense in DePauw history at 41.5 percent. The 1996 team ranked 12th in scoring defense (62.0), while the 1997 squad was 15th (60.9). In 1997-98 the Tigers ranked 20th in free throw percentage at 73.6 percent. The 1998-99 team was sixth in free throw percentage (76.3 percent) and 35th in three-point percentage (38.8 percent), while the 1999-2000 squad was third in three-point percentage (41.3).

Fenlon's head coaching career began at the Berkeley Preparatory School in Tampa, Florida. He also was an assistant coach for Team Florida, a 19 & under AAU team, that captured the AAU national championship. That team also had six future NBA draft picks on its roster. His first coaching job was as head coach of the Tampa Preparatory School where his team set the school record for victories in a season during the 1981-82 campaign.

Fenlon's collegiate head coaching career began at the University of the South in 1985 where he directed the program for three years and led the Tigers to a first-ever national ranking (20th) in 1988. He was an assistant coach there from 1983-85.

He then took over at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology in 1988 and immediately led the Engineers to a 19-7 record for the most wins in seven years. His three-year stint included an NCAA Division III tournament appearance and a first-round victory in 1989. He posted a 53-26 career record at Rose-Hulman and the Engineers ranked among the top 15 in Division III in scoring defense each year.

A head coach during the 1991-92 season at Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas, Fenlon improved Southwestern from an 8-19 record in 1991 to 19-10. The team ranked in the top ten, nationally, in scoring defense.

A 1979 graduate of Northwestern University, Fenlon earned a bachelor of science degree in communications with a minor in English. He also earned three letters as a member of the Wildcats basketball team. Fenlon was an all-state high school player at Marist High School in Atlanta and was inducted into its athletic hall of fame in 2006.

Fenlon's wife, Gigi, is the coordinator of arts publicity and marketing at DePauw and a part-time instructor of communication and theatre. The Fenlons are the parents of Hannah who attends Kenyon and Quinn who is a student at Brown.
